

Crisis Ministry: Provides food, clothing, furniture and emergency financial assistance for utilities, rental assistance to keep families intact, in their homes and on the job.

Jail Ministry: Provided meaning and direction to inmates through Bible studies, religious materials and chaplaincy. **Homeless Ministries:** Served 812 homeless, provided 690 homeless with transitional housing, and provided 5,546 overnight stays for over 110 persons; plus the Code Purple van went out to distribute food and blankets to encampments. **Employment and Training Ministry:** 467 total employed; and an average job placement rate of 56% **Medical Clinics** Served about 30% of unincured in Buncamba Co., and distributed \$3,342,550 in medicine.
