The set, props, costumes, live animals, Roman soldiers, and shopkeepers help convey the story of that most important night over two thousand years ago - a story that all hearts then and now long to hear ... the story that actually came true.

Holy Family

The Holy family is the central part of Return to Bethlehem. Mary, Joseph, and a baby between birth and four months old in the quiet of the manger. The audience will travel twenty minutes through the noise of Bethlehem's streets and will end at the manger pondering the ultimate story that came true. Holy Families will have 90 minute slots and their own trustworthy attendant for costume and/or help holding the baby, in a separate room. Baby feeding time, bottled water, or other help will also be discretely provided during performance. This is a great memory for the parents and the child. If only one parent can attend, we will have a Joseph or Mary available to stand in.

Musical Performances

Share your church's musical talents! An Advent medley of Christmas songs and/or hymns help guests wait and prepare for their walk through Bethlehem. Ask your church's music ministry members, teens needing performance practice, or adults who still love to play or sing. All sets are 30 - 60 minutes.

Actors

Costumes provided; costumers will help you. Catered food provided with sandwiches, hot soup, dessert, snacks, and water. Water and mints will be discretely taken to actors during the performance as well. This is a great way to act out faith and build fellowship among Sunday School classes, small groups, Bible studies, civic organization, and neighbors. Speaking parts are brief one to four lines. Many family and couple roles are available. All ages are needed. Children are very welcomed, but they need to enjoy being in character through a three hour shift with brief breaks permitted. Enjoyable roles include but are not limited to shopkeepers of various types, woodworkers, Roman guards, Jewish prisoners, small animal handlers, temple children, women at a well, and more.

Performers provide holiday music, hymns, soft instrumentals, duet, quartet, acapella, etc. for a 30-minute set in the church sanctuary to set the mood while people await their journey through Bethlehem. To arrange for a performance time, call Rev. Nick Honerkamp at 398-6833.
